The fastest way to stall an AI program is to discover, after the fact, that sensitive data left the building, that no one owns the model's decisions, or that "shadow AI" is already running unmonitored across the organization. Governance is not the brake on adoption; done correctly, it is what lets leadership say yes with confidence.

► GOVERNANCE BUILT IN, NOT BOLTED ON
